




## COMBO SETUPS FOR THE NORTHWEST


### Free-Sliding Jet Diver™ & Kwikfish® Rig



### Free-Sliding Jet Diver™ & Double Bait Backtrolling Rig



### Free-Sliding Double Plug Backtrolling Rig



Note: The legal number, style and size of hook do vary from state to state. Check current fishing regulations.

Diving capability depends upon lure speed, line diameter, and distance between plug and rod tip. Faster lure speed, smaller line diameter and greater distance provide maximum dive.



### **HOT SHOT®**

All Hot Shot sizes are excellent trolling/backtrolling plugs for salmon, steelhead and trout. Larger sizes make great casting lures too. All feature stainless steel split rings, extra-strong VMC® hook, diving lip and a wide-wiggle action. The Hot Shot 35 size rattles. All can be fine-tuned, which is accomplished by turning the stainless steel screw eye (located on the diving lip) a slight amount. If the lure runs to the right, turn screw eye counterclockwise. If it runs to the left, turn the screw eye clockwise. Remember to always use the round-eyed Duo-Lock Snap that comes with each lure.

### **JET DIVER™**

The diver/bait backtrolling technique has become a standard among river salmon and steelhead anglers. Many are beginning to rig their divers free-sliding for easier strike I.D., hook set and a leverage-free fish fight. Free-slide rigging is optional with the standard Jet Diver, but becomes necessary when using the new free-sliding double-bait rigging. Free-slide rigging is standard on the largest 6" Jumbo size.



When the goal is to achieve maximum diving depth from the Jet Diver braided superlines are the way to go. Because they offer incredibly small diameters for their strength, braids like Sufix® 832® Advanced Superline® Braid generate very little water resistance reducing one of the largest limiting factors in Jet Diver diving depth. For example, 30-pound 832® has a diameter equal to just 8-pound monofilament, while 50-pound has the diameter of only 12-pound monofilament.

### **KWIKFISH®**

The standard salmon size Kwikfish (K14, K15 and K16) feature wide action, medium dive capability and stainless steel screw eyes. The all the X-treme (X) series Kwikfish feature fixed eyelets, side-to-side body construction and are deeper diving than our standard models. Remember to always use the round-eyed Duo-Lock Snap that comes with each lure.



You should always use a premium quality braided or monofilament line that has superior knot strength, small diameter in relation to pound test and is abrasion resistant.
